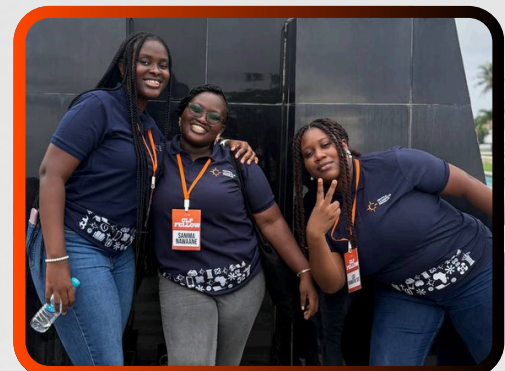

Transforming Campus Mental Health

BOE Kwaku Ofose-Appiah (Gold Cohort 7) is transforming youth mental health through Inhale Exhale, a monthly initiative for open learning and reflection.
