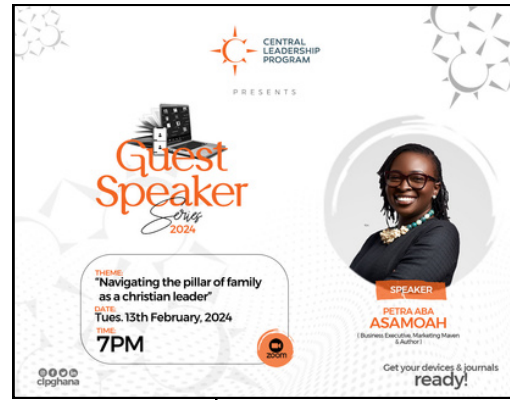

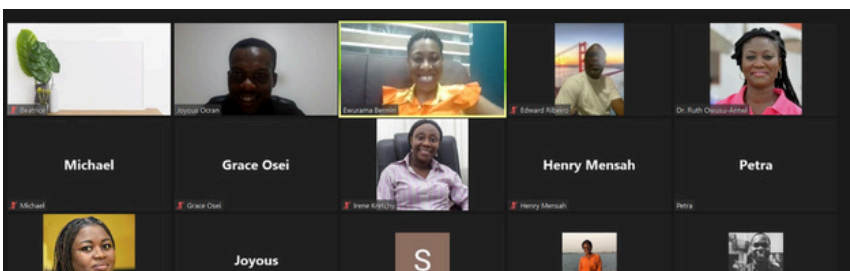


MENTORS' TRAINING SESSIONS

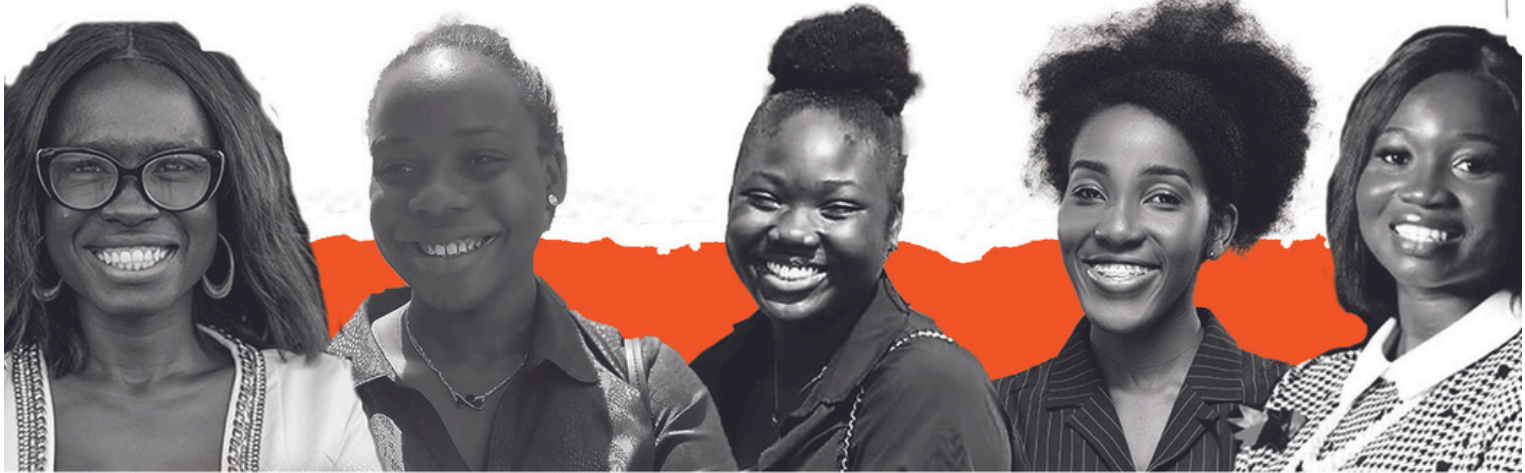
