## EPL BY THE FIRE SIDE CHAT

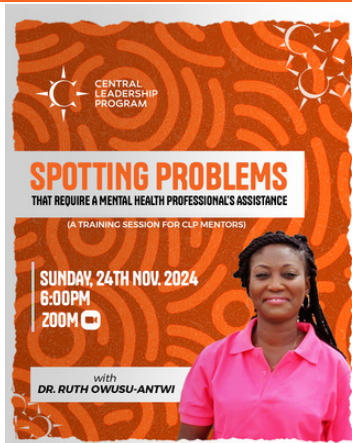

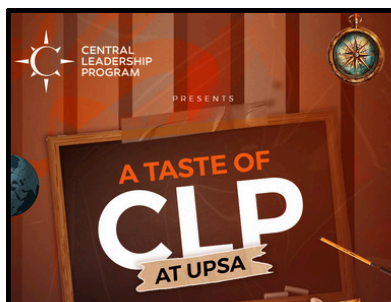


## MENTORS TRAINING
