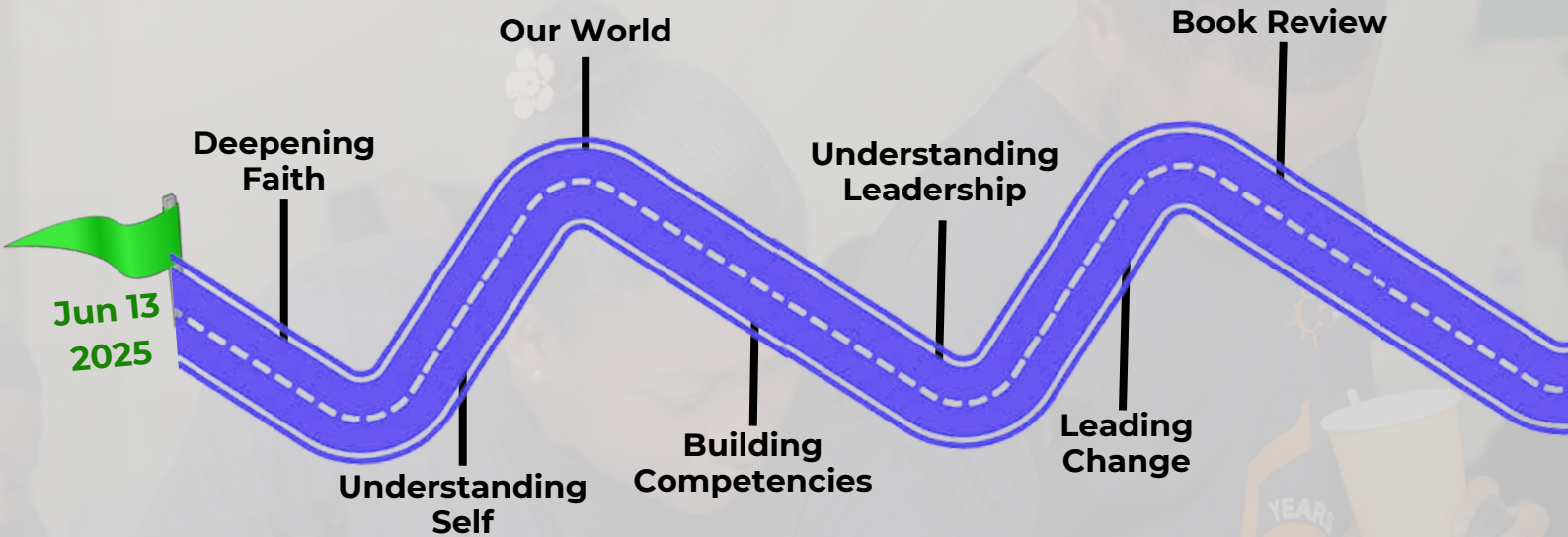

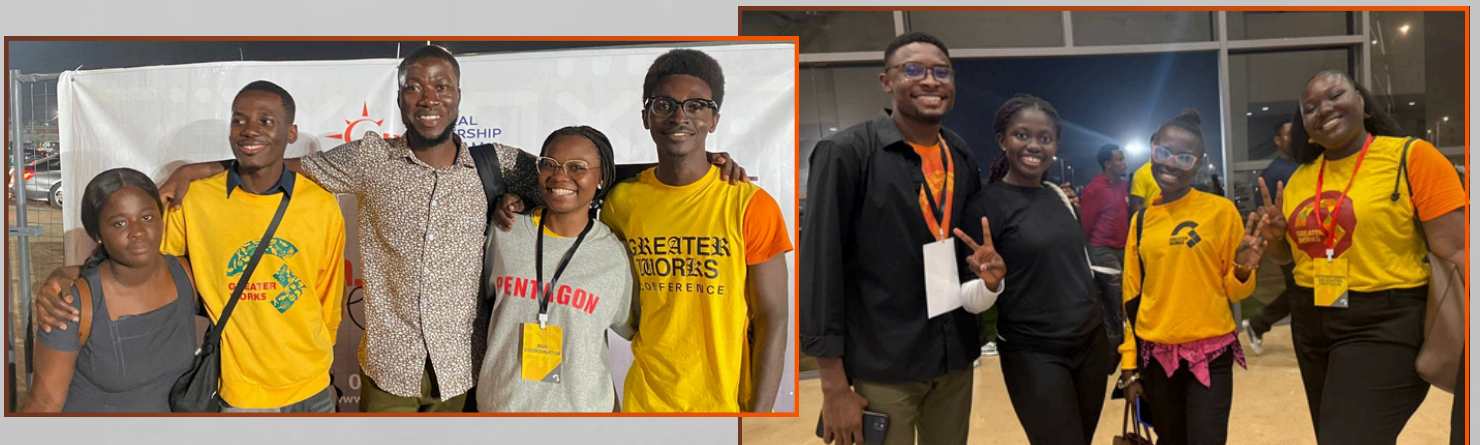


CLP LIVE AT GREATER WORKS!

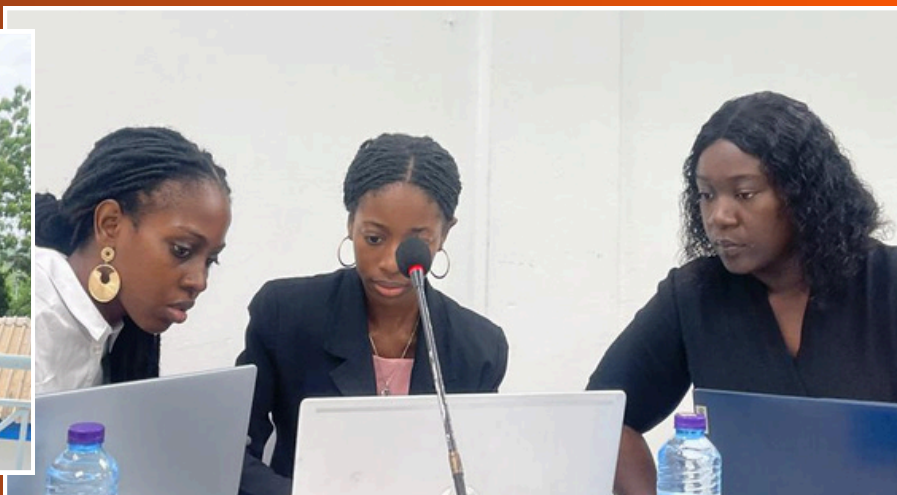
Balancing Research, Mentorship, and Growth

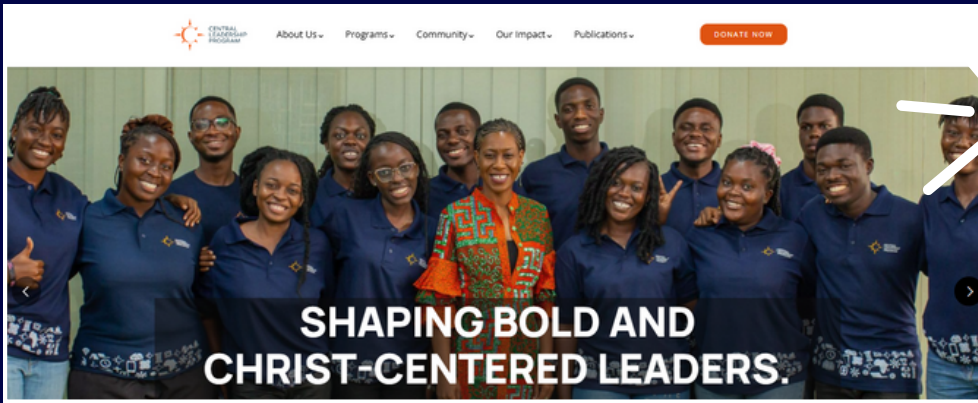
We are excited about our growing collaboration with the **Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship International (FGBMFI)**.
